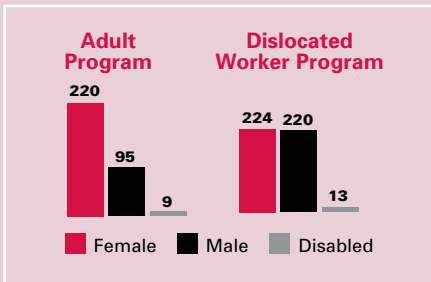

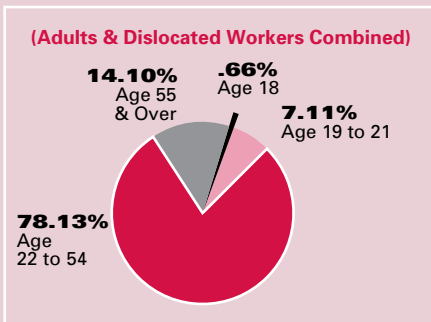

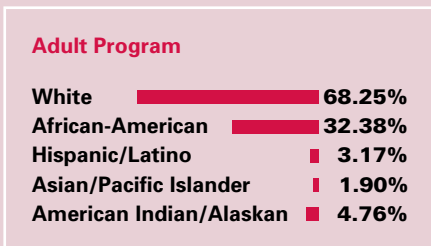
BY GENDER

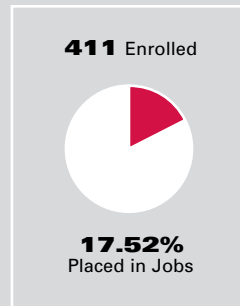

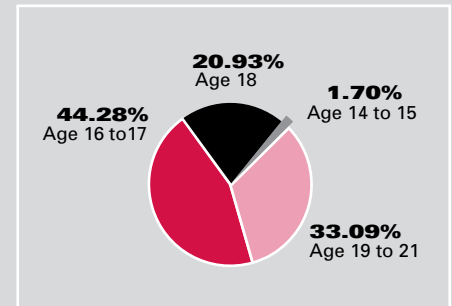

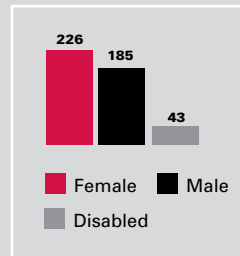

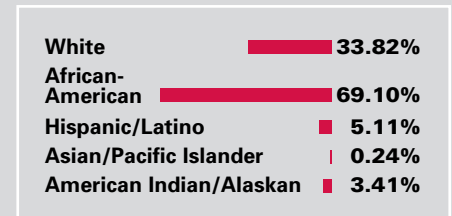

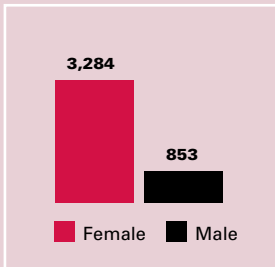

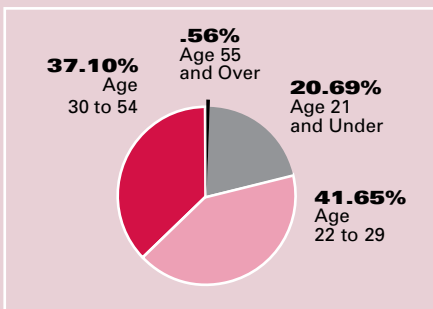

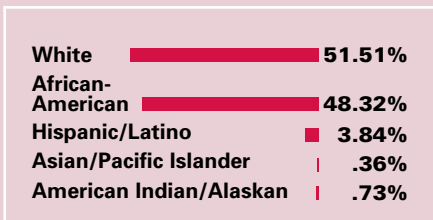
BY GENDER



BY AGE

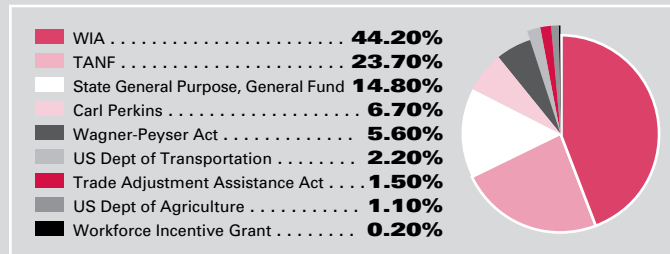


BY ETHNICITY

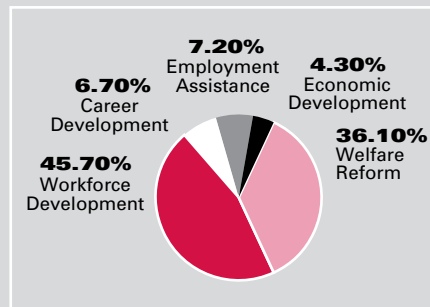


DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS*
